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FOR WHOM?

WHAT IS THE GOAL?

To learn or develop the ability to design applied research to diagnose or improve collaborative information behaviour solutions in digital information environment.

Applied research is understood here as any investigation using scientific methodology to acquire new knowledge (or to use previous scientific achievements) with the direct aim of changing any specific and particular aspects of reality in a desired direction or deciding not to change it at all.

Collaborative information behaviour (CIB) comprises any information behaviours in taskoriented groups working together to achieve common goals. It includes behaviours that are exhibited when people work together to:

- · identify their information needs · seek the needed information through searching and sharing information
 - · use the information found to achieve the intended goals
- · manage of acquired information
