The Una Europa Cultural Heritage Winter School 2027 takes the form of an Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Programme (BIP), combining a short in-person programme with online components before and after to connect participants and facilitate collaborative working. BIPs are eligible for dedicated funding through Erasmus+.

Please note: Erasmus+ funding for BIP mobility is not available for doctoral researchers at KU Leuven or for doctoral students with employment contract at Helsingin yliopisto/Helsingfors universitet. Doctoral researchers at the University of Edinburgh and Universität Zürich are not eligible for Erasmus+ but may receive alternative funding from their home university.
