Una Europa's Interdisciplinary Doctoral Training Programme, taking place in November 2025, takes the form of an Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Programme (BIP). BIPs are eligible for dedicated funding through Erasmus+.

Please note: Erasmus+ funding for BIP mobility is not available for doctoral researchers at KU Leuven. Doctoral researchers at Edinburgh, Helsinki and Zürich are not eligible for Erasmus+ but may receive alternative funding from their home university.
