What does it involve leading a TRT

The TRTs are designed as forums for debate and exchange of ideas. Each TRT is academically steered by 3 academic coordinators from different Una Europa universities. They launch and manage activities enabling Una Europa researchers and doctoral students to meet up (online or hybrid). Since the TRT participation represents a mandatory part of the curriculum of Una-Her-Doc), at least 2 annual "get togethers" should be organized by each TRT, giving TRT researchers and Una-Her-Doc doctoral candidates a possibility to present their research.

TRT coordinators are assisted by one research assistant per team, from the Una-Her-Doc doctoral candidates (approx. 50 hours per year, remunerated by Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne university, leader for this activity). The research assistant is responsible for practical organization of TRT activities. The TRTs collaborate closely with the Una Europa Cultural Heritage Self-Steering Committee, in charge of the development and implementation of Una Europa Cultural Heritage strategy and action plan.
