

Una Europa Cultural Heritage Transnational Research Teams (TRTs) Research Assistants

Université Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne is recruiting 4 Una Europa TRTs research assistants to assist TRTs academic coordinators and participate in developing and implementing TRTs research agendas and activities. One research assistant per team will be employed for a total of 50 hours until the end of 2024. The position can be renewed for 2025.

Missions:

The TRT research assistants are placed under the scientific authority of the TRT's coordinators. Their main missions are:

- Animating, under the supervision of the TRT leaders, a group of TRT members
- Participating in the development of a TRT research agenda and activities
- Coordinate the practical organization of TRT activities: get togethers, creation and feeding in the blog or website, research proposals development

Why apply:

- Help build Una Europa's unique transnational research network. Develop closer collaboration with the TRT coordinators and other TRT members, but also invited guests both from Academia and beyond
- Gain first-hand academic knowledge in the TRT topic
- Develop transversal competences in research coordination, project development and management, event organization, research priorities development

Eligibility:

The call is open to 3 cohorts of Una-Her-Doc Doctoral candidates, with a confirmed research or professional experience in the TRT's topic (publications, topic of the doctoral dissertation, participation in research projects or teaching, professional experience). The research assistant should be fluent in English, which will be checked during an interview.

How to apply:

Remuneration:

Each research assistant will be paid at the hourly research administration rate for Paris 1 (approx. 20€/hour).

Documents to submit

- Letter of motivation, explaining how the topic of the TRT the student is applying for is related to his/her research and professional experience (1 page)
- A document outlining student's main ideas for the TRTs development (1 page)
- Letter of the supervisor that he/she is supporting student to apply
