

Our mission? Re-thinking the University of the Future.












- 1. Envisioning reports inspired the creation of our position paper, "The European University of the Future".

The Future UniLab Workflow















The Future UniLab Structure

Once the challenges and opportunities are selected, they are handed to the Visionary teams.



- Position paper





Fundamental problems for the future of universities.





Circumstances potentially enabling rapid changes.






Complexity


The Evolving Role of the University

What will the university of 2050 look like—and what role should it play in a rapidly changing world? This visionary theme invites us to think critically about the future of higher education in the face of global challenges and emerging opportunities.

Core Values of Higher Education

What should guide universities in times of uncertainty? How can they stay true to their mission while navigating global challenges? This theme invites participants to reflect on the fundamental principles that define higher education, from academic freedom and open discourse to resilience, responsibility, and global engagement.

How can universities balance the need for international academic mobility with the urgent call for sustainable practices and reduced environmental impact?




The <u>Una Forest</u> concept aims at offsetting the environmental impact of academic travel by supporting sustainable reforestation efforts.


