Today, urban fringes incorporate former medieval villages, industrial areas, transport infrastructure, social housing, modern residential architecture... offering a palimpsestic and emerging heritage. They have been the settling ground of newcomer populations (former colonies, countryside or recent immigration), and possess intangible heritages that reflect the social and cultural mix of their inhabitants. Considering that cultural heritage plays an important role in the economic, cultural and social revitalization of urban peripheries, CUTE will analyze the challenges and possibilities of heritage development in the urban fringes of UNA Europa cities, with an interdisciplinary and intersectoral approach.
