



Recycle Enough? A Multi-Country Survey on Attitudes (REMCSA)

This interdisciplinary project aims to determine the effectiveness of existing recycling programs, understand the determinants of recycling attitudes, and suggest ways to improve recycling at both stages in several European cities. The first part involves tracking recyclable items to check how many of them reach the designated recycling facilities. The second is a survey about consumers' willingness to recycle and how it depends on the information about the effectiveness of the recycling system. The proposal was envisaged as a long-term research program to provide the basis for further experiments, and inform a broad array of stakeholders, e.g. academics, professionals and policy-makers.
