Veterinary surgeons working on farms and at food-processing establishments play a fundamental role in safeguarding public health and animal welfare. As such, an essential part of the veterinary undergraduate training in Europe involves students undertaking placements within abattoirs. However, several issues have adversely affected the ability of students to gain such work placements. The project aim is to create a forum of multidisciplinary academic expert to support in an evidence-based manner the development of Virtual Slaughterhouse Simulators and other e-learning tools that will inform sustainable advances in Veterinary Public Health and meat hygiene pedagogy in Europe and internationally.
