The project establishes a series of webinars, as well as a cooperation network in general, under the main topic of "The role of academia in transition to sustainable food systems." Aims of the webinars will be: to start an interdisciplinary, multi-stakeholder dialogue on the role of academia in sustainable food systems; to promote long-term research collaboration; to produce an open access publication on the topic; to prepare a Horizon Europe (or INTERREG EUROPE) project proposal; to pave the ground for the establishment of a pan-European network of **Budget**: €13,000 "Universities 4 Sustainable Food Systems"; and to support early career researchers to become better embedded in research networks.
