ILIO, conceived by the Departments of Italian Studies of the partner Universities, envisages the organisation of a series of seminars, both in person and online, between senior and junior scholars on multiple issues affecting contemporary Italian literature observed from an international and interdisciplinary perspective.

The reflections from the seminars will be collected in a multilingual volume of essays that will be published by an international Open Access publishing house and will be used as handbook for the future ILIO school (Bologna, Summer 2023), open to early career researchers and postgraduate students. This project represents the first step towards the creation of an International Observatory on Contemporary Italian Literature, based in the four partner Departments.

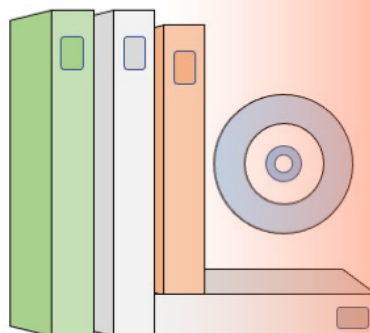
