



# Learning geographical competences and (inter)national urban heritage through online cartography (HERIGEOCARTO)

In times of a global pandemic, people in geography had to find digital alternatives for teaching and data collection that normally would have taken place in the field. This project aims to assess if online spaces can substitute real spaces for learning about heritage and urban space, by studying, through the use of workshops, how students can obtain specific geographical competences through online cartography of (inter)national urban heritage. Students are asked to design a didactic heritage route in the cities of Madrid and Cracow, without visits in person, with only cartographic software at their disposal. The researchers will determine the categories of heritage, create and validate an evaluative questionnaire, and study if and how virtual/digital spaces are useful for this learning.
