The Covid-19 pandemic triggered an era of radical digital transformations for worldwide economies and societies. However, it remains unclear the extent to which digital technologies have supported Social Innovation (SI) models in rural Europe in delivering their on-the-ground objectives to improve the well-being of local communities. iDEAL fills this gap by developing and delivering a survey to European rural SI initiatives to explore the uptake of digital tools during the pandemic and their impacts on the SI's activities and outcomes. The results will serve to identify whether this digital transformation can support or rather hinder the works of social innovators in reconfiguring local networks, attitudes, and governance arrangements to promote new ecological, social, or institutional practices.
