The project aims at giving unity and visibility to the heritage of Una Europa as a consortium of European universities. The focus is on management practices in running university heritage (museums, collections and intangible heritage). This research addresses 8 Universities of Una Europa Network, establishing for each a local team to support the project.

The goal is to fill the literature gap on managerial issues of university museums and collections, to foster coordination among Una Museums Universities, and to facilitate collaborations between Una Europa universities in the field of museums and collections.
