This workshop examines the relationship between changing work and labor conditions, psychological well-being, the provision of mental health care services, and social solidarity initiatives during the Covid-19 pandemic in Germany, Scotland, Finland, Spain, and Poland. New constellations of employment, differential access to services and support, and the toll on mental health reflects changing "orders of feeling" (how are we supposed to feel through the pandemic?) and "economies of solidarity" (what are we supposed to do in the pandemic?) in the wake of Covid-19. By drawing on the unique situation in each country, the project allows for a better understanding of the divergent social and institutional responses. Details
