The project aims to create a new integrated European research team for the sustainable management of big data in Cultural Heritage. The goal is the development of innovative tools for the management and sharing of data and dissemination of results obtained from diagnostic campaigns, and the identification of joint research topics to be developed in the framework of future Initial Training Network (ITN) or European Research Council (ERC) funding calls within the theme of “BIG DATA AND CULTURAL HERITAGE”. The production and management of big data in the field of cultural heritage is an issue still to be addressed, with potentially high impact on diagnostic research, restoration planning and education.
