# Una Europa Early Career Researcher Workshop: Environmental Plant Cell

Plants are continuously exposed to rapid changes in their environment and as immobile organisms have no choice but to cope with environmental challenges. Human-induced climate change is putting additional pressure on plants, so understanding how they tolerate environmental changes is of vital importance to the future of sustainable agriculture. This virtual UNA Europa Workshop was designed by a transnational partnership between the Universities of Edinburgh, Helsinki and Bologna. Under the guidance of research leads, early-career researchers formed trans-national teams designed competitive new research proposals that were then pitched to an expert panel to win prize money to further develop their research ideas.
