The project aims at creating a full-fledged interdisciplinary “Una Europa Global Governance Research Group” composed by Una Europa members. The main goal is to initiate a long-term cooperation to end up building a competitive Research Group that will apply for funding in the future. The project helps identify research synergies, also through a 1st Una Europa Prize competition on global governance and promoting conversations with top officials from institutions like the UN, the WB, the European Commission, the WTO, the IMF, among others. The dialogue with policymakers was opened to the public via website and two seminars for Una Europa researchers were organized.
